MAKE YOUR PLAN

-  Know your pet's hiding place so they are easy to find during an emergency. Be advised that scared cats may try and flee.
-  Think about where you will go if you need to leave home in an emergency.
-  Make sure your cat is microchipped and that they have identifying collars with an emergency contact number.
-  Keep a current photo of your pet in the event that it gets lost.
-  Put together a cat preparedness bin (swipe for what to put in your bin)

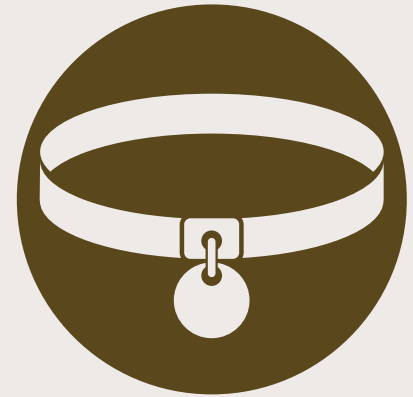
